

## **Update (11/12/20): Outpatient Treatment Services**

Community & Family Resources continues to respond to the evolving COVID-19 pandemic, CDC recommendations, and state guidance. Enhanced safety and sanitation precautions will remain in place at all CFR locations:

- All staff, clients, & visitors are asked to stay
  Frequent hand washing is encouraged **home** if they have COVID-19 symptoms or risk factors
- Face coverings are required to be worn over the mouth and nose at all offices (masks are available if needed)
- Daily temperature screenings are required for all staff, clients, & visitors

- Regularly **sanitizing** office spaces multiple time each day
- Staggered appointment times to reduce
- Re-arranged office spaces and limited group sizes to facilitate social distancing of at least 6 feet between people

- Office Updates:
  - The **Rockwell City** office will be closed for in-person services. Services are available at our Fort Dodge location or via telehealth.
  - The **Pocahontas** office remains closed for in-person services. Services are available via telehealth or at our Fort Dodge or Humboldt locations
  - All other locations including Ames, Boone, Clarion, Fort Dodge, Humboldt, & Webster City - remain open for in-person services and telehealth.
    - Our providers continue to offer the option of telehealth video and phone **services** so you do not have to come into the office for individual appointments. Our staff will help you set up the options available, which include an online video telehealth system called "Zoom" or a phone-only option.
