

Update (6/2/20): Outpatient Treatment Services

Community & Family Resources continues to respond to the evolving COVID-19 pandemic, CDC recommendations, and state guidance. Enhanced safety and sanitation precautions will remain in place at all CFR locations:

- All staff, clients, & visitors are asked to stay
 Frequent hand washing **home** if they have a fever, COVID-19 symptoms, or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
- **Face coverings** are required at all offices (masks are available on site if needed)
- Daily staff temperature checks

- Regularly **sanitizing** office spaces multiple time each day
- Staggered appointment times to reduce
- Re-arranged office spaces and limited group sizes to facilitate social distancing

 - Ames and Fort Dodge <u>IOP (Intensive Outpatient)</u> substance use treatment services will return to in-person services
 - Webster City, Humboldt, & Rockwell City will re-open for in-person services
- Effective **Monday**, **June 15th**:
 - Ames, Fort Dodge, & Boone will re-open for in-person services (EOP substance use treatment & mental health therapy)
 - Clarion will re-open for in-person services.
- Effective Monday, June 22nd:
 - Ames, Boone, & Fort Dodge psychiatry services will re-open for services at the office
