## Question 1:

*In item 2 under Scope, the RFP indicated that creating a sustainability plan to move forward is part of the planning project. The item mentions executing a needs assessment.* 

- Would you outline what you expect from the sustainability plan and needs assessment?
- What is the focus of the needs assessment? Should it be comprehensive? Focused on programs and client services? Or is it specifically linked to organizational capacity and the ability of the organization to implement its strategic plan?

### **Response:**

CFR would expect that the strategic planning team would assess the needs and climate within the behavioral health industry in our geographic area, detailing the opportunities for growth and/or expansion and the steps necessary to reach and sustain those goals.
