### Community & Family Resources Receives Positive Audit Report

Community & Family Resources, a non-profit providing eight Iowa counties with addiction and mental health prevention and treatment services, is ending 2018 with an outstanding audit rating from an outside accounting firm and the election of 2019 board members and the board's executive committee.

Community and Family Resources (CFR) requests an annual audit by an independent firm as part of its fiscal responsibility goals. "Performing an audit each year allows a third party to examine our business activities, and they look to make sure that we are following Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, or GAAP," said CFR Controller, Pamela Barkley. The audit is filed with the State of Iowa, as well as a list of other recipients.

The audit for fiscal year 2018 came back a success. Murray Stanley, a Certified Public Accountant with Schnurr & Company, LLC, stated, "This audit report issued an unmodified audit opinion which is the best opinion a company can receive." An unmodified audit opinion is the result of no or very few errors in the financials from fiscal year 2018. CFR looks forward to what another year will bring with milestones such as the new centrally located Fort Dodge facility set to open in the spring of 2019.
